Soaring times at Eagle Colorado NBHA CO-10 Barrel Race

The wonderful Western Colorado winds played havoc with the electric eyes but thanks to a paint bucket, some baling twine and a few rocks the winds weren't the only things whipping through the arena in Eagle.

The ground remained consistent throughout the day thanks to the month-long efforts of the Eagle County Fairgrounds manager Tom Roberts, Tammy Olson, Wendy Parker and family, Terri Gold and Margie Ward. Due to their perseverance the ground at Eagle was said to have been the best it had been in years.

Trudy Latham took the lead in the Open during the first rake and held it until the next to the last rake. In the number 59 draw position Margie Ward and Native Corn Husker, aka Fitz smoked through the cloverleaf pattern with the fast time of the day 17.825 to win the NBHA Open 1D and the Gymkhana Open Barrels 1D. Latham would finish second.

Recent college graduate Cassidy Kurtz, Steamboat Springs, took the Open 2D win amidst one of the worst gusts of wind all day. Kurtz never lost focus and turned in a smooth time of 18.418.

Abby Zellar, Grand Junction, won the Open 3D on Zanzu Cat De Great, aka Tater and also collected Open 4D points on a young horse affectionately known as Ivan. Zellar would make the trick ride of the day in the Gymkhana pole bending.

Aboard Chance Fantasy Bar, Barb Steele, Delta took the Open 4D win.

In Youth competition one of the youngest youth members, TayLour Latham, DeBeque, had a smoking fast run aboard Lexus to win the Youth 1D. Latham had just changed her competition District from WY-04 to CO-10 and made the change worthwhile.

Alexa Flower was the lone Youth 3D runner and took home all the 3D money for her efforts. Her Paint horse Treasured Ali managed to also fall in just the right spot in the Gymkhana also collecting all the Youth 3D money.

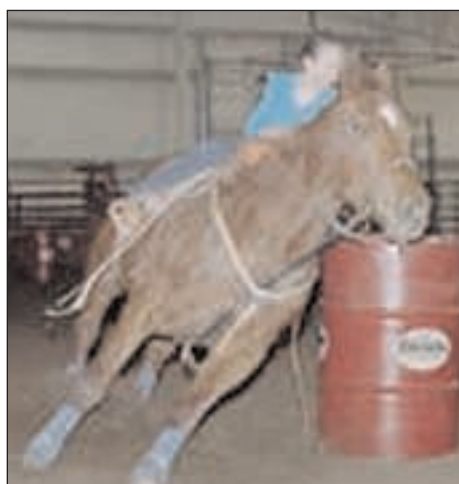
Steamboat Springs is also home to the Youth 4D winner, Hunter Gansmann. Hunter proved that she is totally fearless coming through the gate whip at the ready and tearing through the cloverleaf in fine time. Gansmann would also be the 8-13 Gymkhana Pole Bending winner.

Senior competitors stepped it up a notch with Pam Isaman and Heidi turning in the 2nd fastest time of the day, 17.955 with her re-run in the Senior race. Isaman would collect all the Senior 1D winnings being the only person in that division.

Razor Wire carried Becky Carson to the Senior 2D win. Carson also collected Open 2D money with her time of 18.458.

Arthene Robins didn't let a change of horsepower keep her out of the money. Riding KC Binger's sorrel gelding Johns Gift of Life Robins seemed to find a fit with the horse winning the Senior 3D.
